Everything we do is to make a difference to our students – so we do not expect staff to do things that will not make a difference. The Staff Pledge is regularly reviewed.

Things you can expect from working here-

- One extra non-contact period per week to support preparing and planning high quality lessons
- Exceptional personalised CPL opportunities for teaching and professional services. This includes the range of NPQ courses, a funded Masters and the opportunity to engage in research.
- A culture of typicality in lessons: 'engaging, enthusing and inspiring every lesson every day'. We do not grade lessons, and our ethos is developmental not judgmental
- You don't get extra marks for working late- work / life balance is important
- Professional IT and media support
- We don't expect to see lesson plans
- Only 5 data entries per year
- Staff don't write reports to parents / carers
- Sensible marking expectations – we only feedback to students on things that actually make a difference to their learning
- A dedicated pastoral support team
- Opportunities to work across a growing Trust with a national reputation
- Comprehensive induction and support programme for all new staff- especially ECTs
- Opportunities to progress in your career – whatever your aspirations
- Everyone has the highest expectations of behaviour. All staff (not just teachers) reinforce these expectations
- Our students should be 'Prepared for Excellence'. If they are not, they can expect to be sanctioned
- Leadership Team are very visible, supportive and do all lunch time duties
- Open-door Leadership Team- no problem is too small
- There is a culture of lifelong learning (we are proud of our links with the Chartered College, Universities, SSAT, YST, Teacher Development Trust and other networks)
- Other staff benefits including access to a state-of-the-art fitness suite, free annual flu jab, the cycle to work scheme plus many more
- Every teacher has an iPad
- Exceptionally well maintained environment with World Class displays and display technician
- Regular wellbeing and tips for positive mental health
