### Entry routes:

There are no set routes, you could; apply for a place on a management trainee scheme or apprenticeship with a hotel company, complete a diploma or degree in a subject like hotel or hospitality management or apply for a junior position in a hotel or restaurant, like front of house manager or kitchen supervisor, to build your experience

Some jobs may ask for a driving license, and the ability to speak more than one language.
