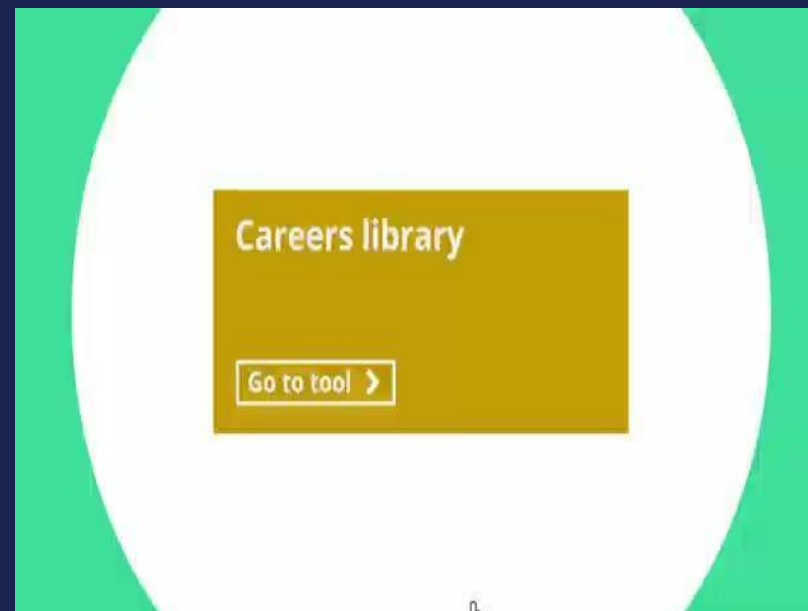

Entry routes:

- a Level 2 qualification in Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair
- a driving licence for road testing the vehicles you've repaired

You can gain your Level 2 qualification via apprenticeship or via a college course

Motor mechanic average salary: £30,000

Working hours: You'll usually work between 38 and 45 hours a week, Monday to Saturday. You may have to work shifts or work late to finish a job. If your employer deals with breakdowns, you may be on call and have to travel long distances.
