


Measles / MMR Information from Vaccination UK



There has been an outbreak of Measles in the West Midlands. Vaccination UK have been instructed by NHSE to administer the MMR vaccination to all school aged children who are outstanding one or both doses. The MMR would have first been given at the age of 1 year old, and the second dose at 3 years and 4 months.

If your child is outstanding one or both doses of the MMR, please contact Vaccination UK on 01384 431712 to make an appointment. **The vaccination will be at an alternative venue and NOT at school.** Vaccination UK are also able to administer the MMR vaccination to any adult who requires either dose, please check the NHS app, to see if you are eligible, prior to calling Vaccination UK. Attached to this newsletter is a list of symptoms and details of clinics that are providing the MMR vaccine. Please note: **Unfortunately, there are no clinics in Dudley at the moment.**



Information Parents and Carers need to know about MyLOL

"The #1 teen dating website in the world" - That's the claim of MyLOL, which offers 13 to 19 year olds the chance to rate each other's pictures, send private messages and contact strangers online.

If that sets your alarm bells ringing, you're not alone: law enforcement agencies and schools in several countries have seen fit to issue warnings about the platform.



Among the main issues is the fact that MyLOL doesn't have a reliable age verification method, meaning there's no foolproof way to stop anyone outside the platform's intended age group range from signing up for an account under a false age.
