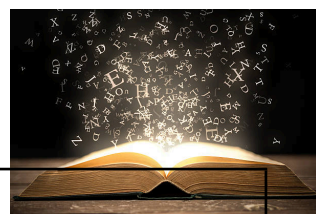

Content	<p>Paper 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Macbeth - answer one question, beginning with an extract (30 marks + 4 marks A04*) • Jekyll and Hyde - answer one question, beginning with an extract (30 marks) <p>Paper 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An Inspector Calls - a choice of a theme and character question, students must answer one (30 marks + 4 marks A04*) • Power and Conflict comparison - students are given one poem from the anthology we have studied and must compare this to another poem within the anthology (30 marks) • Single Unseen Question - students will answer a question on a poem they have not studied (24 marks) • Unseen Poetry Comparison - students will compare methods in the previous poem with a further unseen poem <p>* spelling, punctuation and grammar</p>
