- You will be sitting six papers
  - Biology Paper 1 and 2
  - Chemistry Paper 1 and 2
  - Physics Paper 1 and 2
- Combined papers will be 75 minutes long and Triple papers will be 105 mins long.
- **You should bring a calculator to ALL science exams as well as your stationery.**
- Topic lists and Knowledge organisers for revision are on your Google Classrooms. These will help you to know which chapters of your revision guides to use.
- In your chemistry exam you will be supplied with a periodic table.
- In your physics exam you will be supplied with a **full** formula sheet showing all equations. There is a copy of this on your Google Classrooms.
